PDF Render Center 6 - New Version of Software for PDF-based DMS Solutions

(Bochum, Germany, August 19 2010)

soft Xpansion has released version 6 of [PDF Render Center](#), its company solution for PDF-based Document Management Systems.

Developed for company networks, PDF Render Center 6 works as PDF Server. It converts documents into standard file formats (PDF and image files). Afterwards, the application distributes the resulting files automatically. Conversion and distribution are administered centrally by the PDF Server. PDF Render Center 6 includes both the license to create PDF files on multiple client computers (multi-user license) and special technical features to efficiently use it in multi-user environments. It can be easily integrated into existing document management systems and is able to process large amounts of documents or data. At the same time, it reduces the costs for systematic processing, copying and archiving.

Additional advantages are lower current operating costs, customer relationship encouragement as well as improved coordination with standard software, with toolkits and with individual software which is integrated into content management, ERP- and other systems.

The converted documents and data will be available in back end systems, for administration in databases as well as in document management and content management systems. Any content, previously unstructured or not, can be systematically organized, archived, protected and sent with PDF Render Center 6. All related tasks will be fulfilled more comfortably and quickly. Documents and data can be integrated from each workstation on the network and will be available for safe cooperation in teams - within the company and outside.

PDF RENDER CENTER 6 AT A GLANCE

1. The application converts:
 - * All data formats which can be printed from any software
 - * Text files (ANSI and Unicode), RTF files (rich text format)
 - * HTML files or Web sites
 - * Raster images (for example JPEG or TIFF)
 - * PDF documents or pages
 - * Microsoft Office files including meta information (such as links, table of contents (TOC), form fields and control elements, comments) from Word, Excel, PowerPoint documents into PDF documents
2. The output formats: PDF, PDF/A, text files (ANSI or Unicode), images (for example JPEG or TIFF), including multi page TIFF files
3. PDF Render Center 6 offers several communication channels towards the end user in a network (for example via Internet Explorer or Outlook). All variants are based upon standard

software. As nearly all companies already use e-mail software and internet browsers, there is usually no need to purchase additional software in order to distribute the converted files and data

4. There are several ways to send the output documents to the end user, for example as copies to a folder or as e-mail attachments
5. Flexible and transparent license and price models allow paying only for the required functionality

*Outlook integration

* Conversion of Outlook message files (MSG)

*Archive files (ZIP and EML): the program extracts files from archives and converts them

*Original files and converted files may be placed together in one output folder

* Differing layouts of the original source files may be standardized into a common layout by using predefined template layouts (for example by using common headers and footers, watermarks, page orientation)

* Improvement of existing features

PRICING

PDF Render Center 6 is not sold following a predefined price list. Instead, for each client individual prices apply, depending on the company's requirements with regard to the program. However, the price depends on three basic parameters: the provided functionality, the number of workstations in the network (number of network users) which will use the application and finally the data traffic with it, that is the number of pages which will be processed during a week.

Prices start at 280,- Euros (plus tax) for the basic module (PDF Render Center 6 Network Printer) with 10 network clients and 100 pages per week.
